

SALE COLLEGE UNIFORM DESCRIPTION

1. Parent Undertaking on Uniform

As a condition of enrolment within the College, all parents are required to sign an undertaking that they will maintain their son/daughter in full College uniform.

The main uniform requirements are described briefly below and in greater detail in the “Student Dress Code” which is available from the College on request.

The uniform and the student dress code are each developed and reviewed by the College Council which has extensive parent representation. Constructive comments about each of these are most welcome.

2. Description of Uniform

Boys & Girls

- Teal College jumper with logo (available in wool or a non-itchy nylon blend)
- College Track and Field Zip Up Jacket.
- Plain black pants (no denim or cargo)
- White cotton shirt or white polo shirt (long or short sleeves).
- A plain white T-shirt may be worn beneath the shirt provided it does not protrude beyond the sleeves of the shirt.
- Plain white or black socks.
- Black enclosed shoes or runners.
- PE uniform – black shorts or tracksuit pants and white polo top (compulsory), No variations are acceptable.
- College Black Polar Fleece Scarf

Boys

- Plain black shorts (no ¾ shorts)

Girls

- Dress of approved style and material.
- Winter skirt of approved style and material.
- Black tights.
- Culottes made from the same material as the dress (Butterick no. 5076).

Points to note

- a) Scuffs, thongs, sandals and raised heels are not acceptable for health and safety reasons. School approved footwear should always be worn. For practical subjects safety dictates that students must wear an enclosed shoe and may be excluded if not compliant.
- b) The VCE jacket is an acceptable alternative top for year 12 students. There is a restriction on the colours allowed and the final design is approved by the Principal.
- c) Music uniform – students who are members of the Sale College Bands are permitted to wear the band uniform during performances.
- d) Specifically excluded (not approved):
 - Cargo style pants

- Corduroy pants and shorts of all types
- Jeans
- Canvas type shorts

3. Dress Code

In addition to the approved College uniform detailed in (2) above the following should also be noted:

- Students will be required to wear College PE uniform for physical education and sport classes or events.
- Jewellery items are required to be removed if the responsible staff member determines that health and safety is at risk.
- Students are expected at all times to dress in a neat and reasonable fashion.
- Singlets should not be worn and shirts should not have unpleasant or offensive slogans and images.
- Revealing clothing is not permitted.
- Hats and other headwear are not to be worn in class unless specified by the responsible staff member for health and safety reasons.
- Students are encouraged to be “sunsmart” and wear appropriate hats outside.
- Sunscreen should be worn in hot weather whilst outside.
